
Volpe and Koenig Attorneys Discuss IP With Cohort of International Entrepreneurs and Business Leaders

On Friday, March 16, 2018, Volpe and Koenig President Jay Halt, Shareholder Robert Leonard, and Associate Dawn Kerner discussed key topics within intellectual property law with a group of international visitors participating in the Department of State's International Visitor Leadership Program coordinated by Citizen's Diplomacy International.
